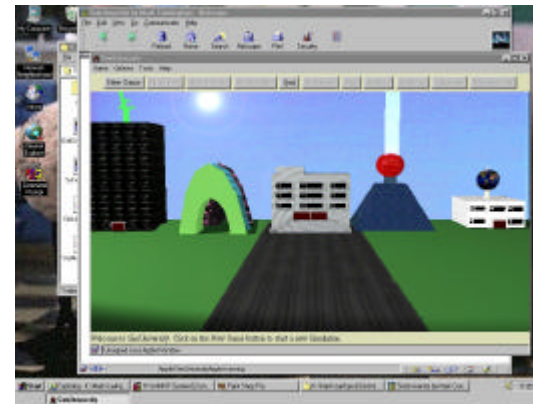
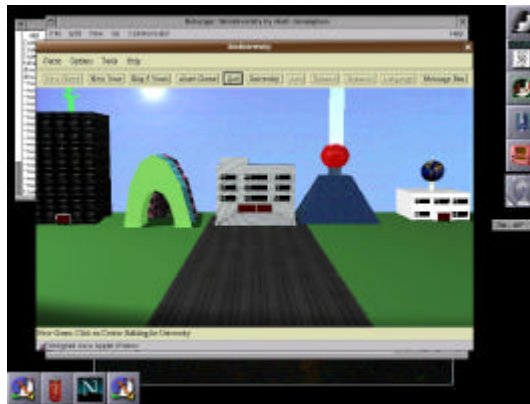

Recommended Method

The Recommended way to run SimUniversity is as an Applet from a webpage. You must have a internet browser such as Netscape 4 Communicator or Internet Explorer 4 (or better). It may not work with earlier versions of such browsers. You must also be run in some graphically platform like NT or Solaris or Linux X-Windows. Then goto

Alternative Method (not supported)

If you do not wish to run it from a webpage you can, alternatively, download all the .class files into a directory and images into appropriate subdirectories. (Refer to <http://www.compapp.dcu.ie/~mcunni.ca4/SimUniversity/SimUniversity.html> for links to all files and directory structure.)

You will also have to have installed something that can run Java files. For example JDK development tools from Sun which is installed in the DCU CA labs (You must have your paths pointing to the JDK executables). As before, you must also run it in some graphical platform like NT or Solaris or Linux X-Windows.

Then run SimUniversity by typing at a prompt (such as X-Term in Solaris or MS-DOS prompt in NT)
